

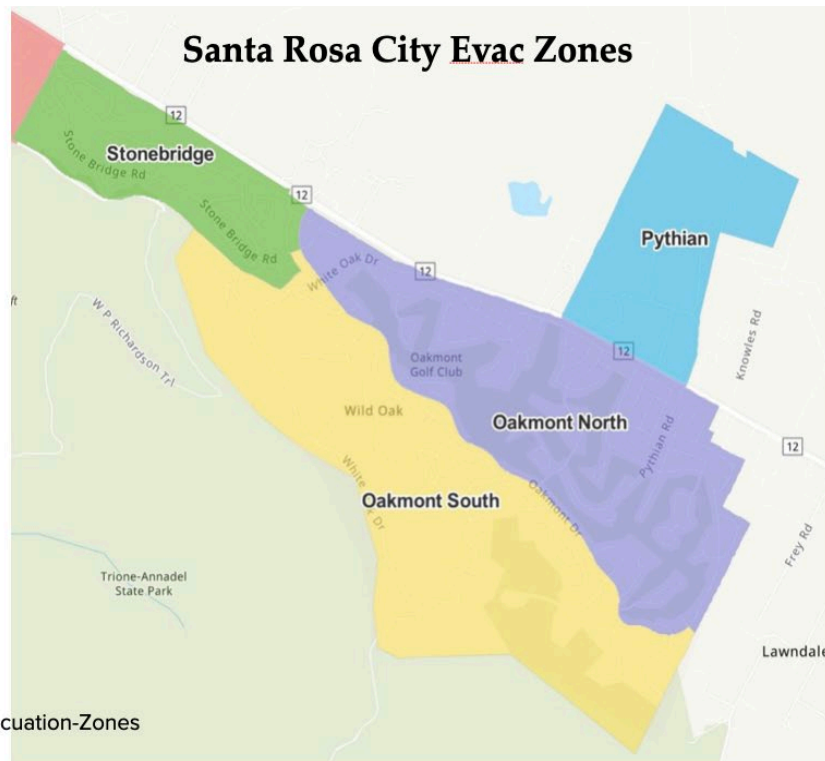
Evacuation Zones

There are two different evacuation zone systems: **City** and **County**. It is important that you know which zone you live in, and frequent so that you are ready to go when an evacuation order or warning is issued for your zone.

1. [Santa Rosa City Evac Zones](#) use neighborhood area names.

- Two key takeaways are:
 - a. Oakmont is in Santa Rosa city limit, and
 - b. Oakmont has three evacuation zones:
 - Stonebridge
 - Oakmont South
 - Oakmont North



If you live in Santa Rosa City limits, you can find your evacuation zone with the **Look-up Search Tool:** [Santa Rosa City Evac Zone](#)

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*The Pythian zone on the map does not refer to Pythian Drive in Oakmont; it's on the Hood Mtn. side of Hwy 12.

2. [Sonoma County Evacuation Zones](#) are identified by letter and number codes. For example, Annadel State Park is “SON-3R1”. County codes surround Oakmont. We suggest you print out and keep a Sonoma County evacuation zone map handy.
